#	Session	Description
1	Opening Session	
2	Presidents (5 sessions)	This all day session is for Presidents, Vice Presidents and Directors. During the session, participants will learn how to develop agendas, conduct elections, understand personality types and manage conflicts. Upon completion of the session, the president will be more prepared to lead a club to greater service success.
3	Secretaries (3 sessions)	The position of club secretary is an important one in supporting the volunteer needs of the club membership. Learn how to complete all the administrative activities of the club including taking minutes, and using MyLCI to complete membership and service activity reporting.
4	Membership Chairs (3 sessions)	This session is for membership chairpersons and membership committee members. During the session, participants will learn how to develop an effective membership and retention plan. They will learn about the various resources to invite and engage members, and as a result allow their club to serve more people.
5	Image & Publicity	Learn about the importance of enhancing your club's image in your community through effective promotion, marketing and branding.
6	Our New Service Framework	Learn about our new service focus areas – Diabetes and Paediatric Cancer – and how your club can help make a difference.
7	Technology	Learn how to use technology in your club to enhance your volunteer experience. Social media, email, websites will be discussed in an interactive session. Bring your notebook or tablet to participate fully!
8	Insurance and Incorporation	Learn about the importance of due diligence and risk management for clubs that includes being adequately insured and incorporated.
9	Managing Conflict	Conflict can arise whenever there are more than 2 people involved. Learn about recognizing and resolving conflict to get people working towards a common goal.
10	Public Speaking	Speaking in front of crowds is one of the greatest fears for many. Learn some simple tips to gain confidence and enhance your speaking skills.
11	Treasurers (2 sessions)	This session is for treasurers and finance committee members. Learn how to manage club finances, including Administrative and Public funds, develop a budget, and pay bills.
12	Attracting Younger Members	Learn how to adapt your club to become more attractive to a younger demographic. Learn how younger members serve and volunteer differently, and how to reach out and invite them to join.
13	Youth Programmes	Learn about our various youth programmes such as Leo Clubs, Youth Exchange, Peace Poster, and Effective Speaking and how your club can participate in them.
14	Diversity	The world is changing. Learn how to recognize the importance of diversity and differences within your club and how it can make your club stronger.
15	Engaging Members	Learn how to keep your members happy, engaged and committed so they can continue to serve your community.
16	Orientation Bingo	This fun-filled session with semi-fabulous prizes is for new and existing members. Learn about our history, structure, and our service.
17	The Art of Recognition	Learn how to offer appreciation and recognize the accomplishments of your members in unique and meaningful ways.
